Now through July 8

- Keep your eye on your mail for your online banking user ID and temporary password (*in June*)
 - Activate Old National Debit Card and select 4-digit PIN (*to begin using July 11*)
 - Create back-up record of bill payee information
 - Download/Print eStatements
 - Ensure Debit Card is "ON" in Online Banking card controls
 - Return Telephone Wire Acknowledgement Form (*if applicable*)

On or after July 11

- If you have not done so, activate your ONB ATM/Debit card
 - Use your new ONB ATM/Debit Card
 - Cut up or shred First Midwest ATM/Debit Card
 - Download Old National Mobile App¹
 - Sign-in to Digital (Online and Mobile) Banking by August 31
 - Remove First Midwest Mobile App
 - Establish Debit Card controls and account alerts
 - Re-register for Zelle^{®2}
 - Re-establish recurring loan payments
 - Confirm accuracy of Bill Payee information and scheduled Internal Transfers
 - Update Digital Wallet with new card information
 - Update recurring payments with new card information
 - Update Quicken or QuickBooks Financial Institution settings (*if applicable*)
 - Order limited time complimentary ONB checks (*available through September 9*)
 - Return Telephone Wire Acknowledgement Form (*if applicable*)
 - Update routing numbers with entities sending wire transfers
